CRAFT AT CAPEL MANOR (9th year)

Capel Manor Horticultural College, Bullsmoor Lane Enfield EN1 4RQ

Once again we have been invited to arrange the craft element of shows at Capel Manor, London's largest specialist centre for horticulture, arboriculture, animal care and countryside studies. Thirty acres surround the College buildings, the Georgian Manor House and the Victorian Stables. It lies just off the A10 (south) 5 mins. from the M.25 within the large affluent catchment area of North London. For the visitor there's easy parking, refreshment facilities and the attraction of high calibre horticulture and genuine craft in lovely surroundings.

The College have decided that their Spring show will be purely horticultural so there will not be a craft element to that show. The Vintage Car show will still feature craft exhibitors in the Manor House (12 exhibitors). Christmas Carousel (20 + exhibitors) will as usual be in the College buildings and will again be over 2 days. Capel is a brown sign site and advertising will be handled by the College, in consultation with us. Publicity appears in local newspapers, Libraries, Tourist Offices etc. & on their website- www.capel.ac.uk. The size of the venue limits the number of large pitches (over 6') please enquire before booking.

CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

1. Fig Fairs reserves the right not to accept a booking, in which case any payment will be returned.
2. **Products must be made solely by the Exhibitor.** No bought-in/franchised goods will be Allowed. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave with no refund.
3. Stalls will be allocated on the basis of one Exhibitor per area booked. Sharing of pitches by two or more crafts will not be allowed.
4. **CONFIRMATION OF BOOKING :** Banking of the deposit cheque is confirmation of an accepted booking. A receipt will be sent by email or if a S.A.E. is enclosed. Otherwise a receipt will be sent with future communications.
5. **CANCELLATION:** In the event of cancellation by the Stallholder made SIX weeks prior to the event the balance cheque will be returned. Refunds of balance cheques after this date will only be considered if the pitch can be re-let.
6. **DISPLAY:** Only the craft stated on the Booking Form can be displayed and **MUST** be produced by the exhibitor. Stalls must be covered to the ground on 3 sides and stock boxes etc. placed under the table, out of sight and clear of walkways. Nothing is to be affixed to the walls of the Venue and the stall should be ready 15 mins. prior to public opening. Late arrivals will only be allowed to set up if the circumstances allow. No Stall shall be dismantled until the close of show. Anyone doing so will not be invited to future fairs.
7. **DEMONSTRATIONS:** These are actively encouraged, small footage is given free space permitting.
8. **INSURANCE:** Each Stallholder is recommended to hold Public Liability Insurance. Venues will be secured overnight (marquee has security) but Fig Fairs does not accept responsibility for loss or damage or action by a third party against the exhibitor, or to interruption of power or cancellation of the event due to inclement weather or matters beyond their control.
9. **ELECTRICITY:** To comply with the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989, all electrical equipment **MUST** be tested annually for electrical safety (PAT Tested)
10. **SMOKING:** In the interest of health and safety, NO SMOKING is allowed at Venues. Young children and pets are regrettably not allowed without prior permission.
11. **VEHICLES** MUST be moved to required parking area as soon as unloaded.
